Mid-year Exams

Mid-year exams start on Thursday 30 July. All exams are held at Clemes. Morning exams start at 8.45am and afternoon exams at 1.15pm. Students need to assemble in the Mark Curtis Foyer at least 10 minutes prior to the exam starting time. Students are not required to wear uniform during the exam period. A copy of the timetable and an instruction sheet outlining examination rules have been distributed to students.

Special Consideration

The Tasmanian Qualifications Authority allows special consideration to candidates who are unable to be assessed in the same way as other students. Consideration may include allowances such as additional time, spelling consideration, special seating, etc. To gain this, students need to provide evidence to support their claim. The forms to make this application for the November exams will be distributed to relevant students later this term. If you feel your child may be eligible for some form of special consideration please ask them to see Lyn Tunbridge, if they have not already done so.

Students who have been allowed additional time in the mid-year exams are reminded that this time is taken at the end of the exam.

Tasmanian Certificate of Education

During tutor periods, after the mid-year exams, all students will be required to check their courses for eligibility for the TCE by completing the Tasmanian Certificate of Education Course Planner as provided by the TQA. For Year 11 students they will need to list the subjects they intend doing in 2010. Subject choices should have been made by this time. Information about qualifying for the TCE is in the TQA newsletter which was distributed to all students this week. We encourage both students and parents to read through the criteria and if there are any questions to contact Lyn Tunbridge.
