CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT

Acceptable Behaviour: Friends' Early Years reserves the right to cancel a child's booking if they behave in a manner that is deemed dangerous or inappropriate.

Accounts: Account statements are generated fortnightly and e-mailed by Thursday. It is a condition of enrolment that **full payment** of the account is made by the **due date** shown on the invoice. Friends' Early Year's accepts payment via Child Care Easy Pay. New families need to obtain an enrolment pack from Friends' Early Years reception.

Age Range: The Friends' School Vacation Care Program provides Vacation Care for children attending Kindergarten and Primary school.

Bookings: Booking sheets are dated when received and places are allocated in accordance with the Government's Priority of Access Guidelines. In the event of an over-demand for places within the same priority area and categories, places will be allocated in order of earliest receipt. The Friends' School Vacation Care Program accepts up to 55 children per day.

Please return your booking slip as soon as possible and by no later than 4:00 pm on Tuesday 4 July 2017. You may cancel part or all of your booking up to this stated date and time without fee or penalty. However, after this stated date and time the full fees shown on our Fee Schedule apply without exception.

Fee Assistance: To claim Child Care Benefit Discount and Child Care Rebate for the **first time**, contact the Family Assistance office on 136 150 and ask them to test your eligibility for Child Care Benefit and Child Care Rebate. You will be given a family Customer Reference Number and a Customer Reference Number for each of the children in your family attending a service. You must then notify Friends' Early Years of these numbers to have your enrolment formalised.

Location: Frank Wells Hall, 395 Argyle Street, North Hobart, 7000.

Signing: Friends' Early Years requires parents/guardians to sign their children 'in' and 'out' of our program each day.

At Home DVD's: We have a list of all the DVD titles that we own on display in our sign-in area. Some of these titles are rated PG. Please take a moment to peruse this list and advise a member of our OSHC team if there are any DVD's on the list that you DO NOT wish your child to view.

Excursions: On excursion days children should arrive at the Frank Wells Hall by no later than 9:00 am. Excursions depart promptly and are not delayed to accommodate late children. Unless otherwise stated in the program notes above, excursions return by 3:00pm. All scheduled picnics will only proceed if weather permits.

Required Items: Children should bring suitable clothing for the season. For example, a coat and warm hat in winter or a broad-brimmed hat and sunscreen in summer. Children should bring morning and afternoon tea, lunch (unless otherwise stated above) and a drink. Children should wear shoes and socks. We strongly encourage parents to clearly label all of their child's possessions.

Screen Time: Friends' Early Years actively promotes limited screen time for children (no more than 1 hour for children aged 0 to 5 years and no more than 2 hours per day for children aged 5 to 12 years). During each vacation care program children are granted the supervised use of an I-Pad for 15 minutes per day and children may have the opportunity to watch one of our DVD's (per above). If you DO NOT wish for your child to have screen time for either or both of these activities, please note this on the sheet provided near the sign in clipboard.

Sometimes Foods: Friends' Early Years actively promotes healthy eating. However, during each vacation care program there may be some times when 'occasional' or 'sometimes' foods may be offered. For example, marshmallows during Winter Craft Day. If you DO NOT wish for your child to have any 'sometimes' foods, please note this on the sheet provided near the sign in clipboard.
