Unused Portion of Upfront Fees

Any unused portion of the charges for uniform, stationery and textbooks will be credited against tuition fees.

Enrolment Conditions / Deposit

For enrolments of less than one year, fees are payable in full at the time of enrolment and include a contingency of AUD\$500.

For enrolments of one year or more, a deposit of one term's tuition and residential fees (where applicable) must be paid. This deposit will be held for the duration of the students enrolment against possible payment default. Provided all fees and charges are paid up to date, families may request that the deposit be offset against the final term's fees for that student. Fees will be billed four times per year.

Payment of Accounts

Accounts covering each school term are issued in February, May, July and October and are immediately due for payment. An accounting charge may be applied to overdue accounts.

Student Withdrawal

One full term's notice in writing, addressed and submitted to the Principal, is required of an intended withdrawal from the School and/or from residential accommodation. Payment of one term's tuition and/or residential accommodation fees will apply if this notice is not received.

Building, Library & Scholarships Funds

The School has a long term strategy that provides for the refurbishment and development of existing buildings. Implementation of this plan is dependent upon the School community raising funds outside the annual budget. On your fees account you will see that you are given the opportunity to make a donation to the *Building & Development Fund* and *Library Fund*. The School also maintains a *Scholarships, Bursaries & Prizes Fund* to which you are also invited to contribute.

Please Note

Boarding is not available during the term holidays between Semester 1 and Semester 2, and during the long holidays at the end of each academic year. The School requires that all students return home during these holidays. Parents may arrange for their child to be cared for by approved family or friends over the age of 25 years. Evidence of appropriate welfare arrangements must be in place and approved by the School, regardless of the age of the student.
