Friends' Alumni Community - Terms of Reference

The Friends' Alumni Community Committee serves four main purposes in eight key areas of responsibility for the Friends' Alumni Community.

Main Purposes

- 1. Foster and promote the Friends' Alumni Community.
- 2. Maintain life-long connections with community members and the School.
- 3. Share Friends' stories.
- 4. Be advocates for the School and its Purpose and Concerns.

Key Areas of Responsibility

- 1. Contribute updates about community activities for the School's publications and communication platforms.
- 2. Develop and support an online community.
- 3. Support Friends' Alumni Community events and activities.
- 4. Provide outreach and support to the Friends' Alumni Community.
- 5. Support occasional School fundraising activities.
- 6. Participate in providing Student Awards and the Award process.
- 7. Participate in student, family and staff leavers events and activities.
- 8. Participate in an annual strategic planning workshop with the Parents & Friends group and the School.

Minutes will be taken and a summary published through School communication channels. The Friends' Alumni Community operates as a Committee that provides Minutes back to the Principal's Committee.

The composition of the group seeks to incorporate:

- Interstate representation;
- Cohort representation (approximately 5 yearly);

Providing the following functions:

- Administration
- Communications
- Community support and outreach
- Events and Awards
- Membership & data, lists
- Technology

Convener/Chair - this role to be fulfilled by and rotated through the above roles

Ex officio members - Director, Community Engagement; Development Manager

School staff by invitation - eg Principal, Deputy Principal, Leadership
