Certificate II in Kitchen Operations

- 30 TCE points.
- Nationally recognised trade qualification; high demand for trained hospitality staff.
- 13 units of study; includes First Aid Certificate; RSA Certificate; Barista Certificate.
- Credit given for qualifications previously obtained.
- RPL (recognized prior learning) given for appropriate industry experience.
- 6 hours/week face-to-face classes.
- Competency based; no exams; most work can be completed in class time.
- Significant practical component; no previous experience or Food courses required.
- Many opportunities for Service in school and wider community.
- A qualified chef works in collaboration with VET teacher to deliver course and provide technical expertise.
- Work Placement and Industry Engagement – minimum 60 hours industry experience through work placement, industry excursions, guest chefs and industry professionals.
