

Years 11 - 12 Boarding Scholarship Agreement

At The Friends' School, we seek to help our students develop as people who will think clearly, act with integrity, make decisions for themselves, be sensitive to the needs of others and the environment, be strong in service and hold a global perspective. We are confident you will be a positive contributor to Walker House and the School community.

The award of this scholarship will attract a 25% reduction in tuition and boarding fees as an affirmation of the strengths and personal qualities you will bring to Walker House and The Friends' School.

As a Friends' Boarding Scholarship recipient, you are a key role model for other boarding students and for the wider School community. There is a level or responsibility associated with the scholarship and in addition to observing the requirements of the <u>Learning Partnership Understanding</u> it is expected that you will:

- Lead by example with the respect that you show for the other members of the School, wider communities and the environment;
- At all times a boarding house scholar will exhibit a high level of respect and kindness toward other boarding students and staff and demonstrate strong social awareness and leadership:
- Always wear appropriate School uniform as outlined in the Friends' uniform guidelines;
- Maintain excellent attendance which includes being punctual for classes and school activities, make an effort to engage thoughtfully in class, complete tasks to a high standard and submit by the due date; and
- Fully meet the requirements of the Friends' Certificate if studying the TCE, or the Creativity, Action, Service (CAS) program if studying the International Baccalaureate; and
- Continue to be a boarding student at Walker House during your schooling at Friends'. If circumstances change and you are no longer going to reside at Walker House, the Scholarship (including the reduction in tuition fees) will be rescinded.

If at any time you find you are struggling to meet the above requirements, it is essential you seek support from a Senior Staff member or the Director of Residence. A Year 11 Boarding Scholarship is applicable for both Years 11 and 12. Scholarships will be regularly reviewed and you will be required to have a formal interview at the end of Year 11. Ongoing concerns may result in the scholarship being rescinded.
